SWIMMING LESSONS – Year 3

Your child will be attending swimming lessons each Thursday during school time starting on 7th September 2017. They will travel on a coach to the EPSV at 10.00am returning for lunch at about 11.30am. The sessions are led by one swimming instructor and two trained staff from our school. Do not worry about children who cannot swim as they will receive close tuition.

The rules at the EPIC are:

- 1 Bring a towel and a swimming costume
- 2 No Jewellery of any kind
- 3 Boys – no swimming shorts allowed – only regular trunks
- 4 Girls – no bikinis – proper all in one costumes please
- 5 Goggles not allowed unless a letter from parents is provided
- 6 No arm bands, floats or any other swimming aids

The children will wear **school uniform** on swimming days. However, to avoid confusion in the changing rooms, you **MUST LABEL ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING CLEARLY!**

Please note that **swimming is part of the national curriculum and is compulsory**. If your child does not bring a costume and towel, then we will have to provide an old one for them to wear. A medical note from your doctor must be provided if the child is not well enough to swim.

We need to ask for parental permission for your child to leave the school site. Please return as soon as possible.
