

## **ST MARY OF THE ANGELS HEADLINE DATA IN 2017 NATIONAL ASSESSMENTS & TESTS.**

Please find attached information about attainment this year, in all areas of the school. **Green boxes** indicate attainment at or above national, at St. Mary of the Angels in 2017.

### **Early Years Foundation Stage (Reception class) results 2017.**

This is the fourth consecutive year that the school has been above or well above national results in early years assessments.

### **Year 1 Phonics Screening Check**

At the end of the first year of the national curriculum (Year 1), pupils are given an external screening assessment, to see if they know their phonics (i.e. the sounds and letters that make up the English language).

Every year, the school has been above or well above the national average with our highest score ever this year as you can see below.

The second year of the more rigorous year 2 testing regime proved a successful one at St Mary of the Angels.

## YEAR 6 TESTS/ASSESSMENTS

Good results against the new more rigorous standards in Literacy at St Mary's in 2017. We had a combined rise of 7% to be in line with national for the second year in a row. Maths results were slightly below expected; one pupil missed the test, one was one mark off the standard, and there were other reasons why they were slightly below expected. However, the school is part of the exciting Cheshire Mathematic Reasoning Project, and improvements in learning & teaching, alongside tracking and progress data in school this year, show that our targets for 2018 are already looking well above this year's scores.
