**Mother's Day fundraiser**

Every child will receive a small paper bag to decorate for Mother's Day. This activity will take place in class during the week beginning 9/3/2020.

On Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March, your child will need to bring £2.50 into school, so they can assemble their Mother's day gift bags. Children will be able to choose items to put in their decorated bags, on a pick and mix basis. Items such as miniature toiletries, nail files, lip balm, fruit tea bags, packets of seeds, bulbs, voucher for unlimited hugs etc, etc will be available. Mums and Dads from Friends of St Mary's will come into school on the Tuesday afternoon and will help the children with this task.

We would hope that most of the bags are made up on this day, but the Friends of St Mary's will be in school again on the 20<sup>th</sup> March, for those children who were not able to take part on the Tuesday.
