Intent

At St Mary of the Angels, we aim to help children to acquire and develop knowledge and understanding of Christianity, and to see our mission and vision embedded across the RE Curriculum. This sits alongside the Gospel values, which are inextricably linked through everything we teach. It is our intention that lessons are faith filled enjoyable lessons, where each child feels they belong to our school community. Lessons should be places where everyone is respected for their beliefs and expressions of faith, but where ultimately, they all achieve. Using the Diocese's RE scheme 'The Way, The Truth, The Life' we plan for outstanding knowledge, understanding and progress. These intentions fall in line with our mission statement to 'Love Jesus, Love Learning, Love Life.'

Implementation

We are a Catholic school and proud of the fact. The Catholicity of the school underpins and permeates through what we do every day. Impact
